

Extension Cables- How to determine if you need a 2 pin or 4 pin extension cable?

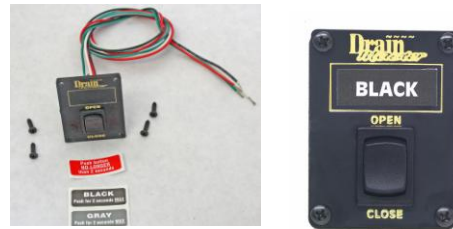
Extension cables for Drain Master electric valves come in two versions. If you are ordering valves and cables that will be used together, you do not need to read the following. We will match up your cables and switches for you.

If however you are adding or replacing a switch or extension cable, the type of plug on the end, needs to match up properly. To determine this, simply follow the wires from the back of your operator switch. They will be approximately 12 inches long. You will find either one plug (pic A) or two small plugs (pic B)

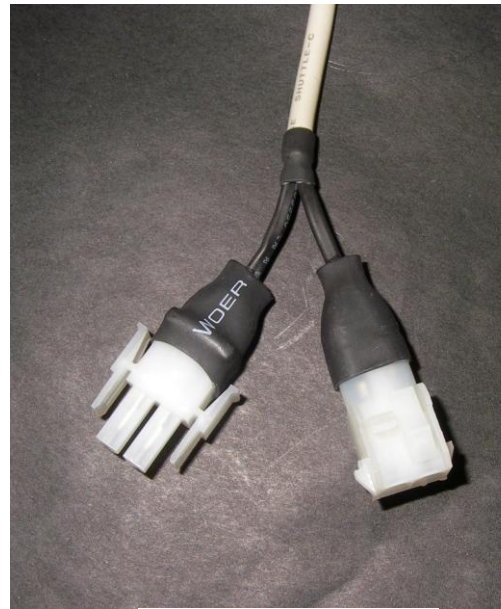
Your operator switch should look like this



If your switch looks like this, (no red light) extension cables are not an option

At the end of the wires you will either find a plug(s) that will plug into the receptacle in picture A, picture B or it may be hard wired.

If your plug looks like Pic A, order a 4 digit part number such as 5218

If your plug looks like Pic B, order a 5 digit part number with a -1, such as 5218-1
