If your LED does not go out, first check to see that the gate is completely closed. This can be done using the manual override. If light goes out, you could have a blockage in the gate area. If light does not go out, try putting a magnet on the switch that is mounted on the valve. If light does not go out, the switch is shorted and will require replacement. If light does go out, when magnet is placed on the switch, there is debris in the gate area.
